ANNUAL GLOBAL MONEY WEEK 10-17 MARCH 2014

The Reserve Bank, will this year participate in the Global Money Week commemorations to be held from 10th to 17th March, 2014.

The Global Money Week (the Week) was established by the Child and Youth Finance International (CYFI), a global network dedicated to promoting financial inclusion and economic citizenship education for children and the youth. The objective of the Week is to inform and encourage children and the youth around the world to take interest in expanding knowledge and engagement in responsible finance management matters. The Week also aims to ensure that children and the youth have access to safe and trustworthy financial services, and that they have the skills, knowledge, attitudes and opportunities required to responsibly and prudentially use those services.

The Global Money Week is commemorated in March every year. This year's commemorations will be done under the theme: "*What do the children and youth want for their future*". In this respect, affiliated organisations are called upon to organize activities befitting children and youth.

In celebrating the week, we wish to inform the general public of Reserve Bank's commitment to promote financial inclusion for children, the youth and the general public through various financial literacy and education initiatives. In commemorating this year's Global Money Week, the Bank has organized a couple of financial education activities including education visits to the Reserve Bank and some financial services providers and students' financial education students' talk show program to be aired on television and radio stations.

In addition, the Bank will publish a number of articles on critical financial literacy and education topics from Monday 10th March to Sunday 17th March 2014. Start alert!
